

## THE BACK-UP PLAYER GAME

- The teacher sends a short ball to P3. P3 hits the short ball and moves to the net to play the point against P1 and P2 (corridor in play for P1-P2 but not for P3).
- If P3 is unable to intercept the ball at the net, P4 becomes the back-up player and helps P3 to play the point against P1-P2.
- At the end of the point, P3 goes to the back of the row, P4 receives the short ball and P5 becomes the back-up player. After 5 minutes, the 2 players (between P3, P4, P5 and P6) with the most points will replace P1 and P2.
